

RYA Level 2 Powerboat Handling

This two-day, entry level course provides the skills and background knowledge needed to drive a powerboat. It focuses on low speed close quarters handling, man overboard recovery, an introduction to driving at planing speed, and the collision regulations. Also useful for understanding the requirements for crewing on the Club's range of Rigid Inflatable Boats (RIBs).

Your certificate will be endorsed "Coastal" to reflect the course content covering tidal waters. Level 2 Powerboat Handling is the basis of the International Certificate of Competence (ICC) for which you can apply to the RYA (for coastal waters and powered craft up to 10 length).

Minimum duration	2 days
Minimum age	12 years. Candidates under the age of 16 will be issued with an endorsed certificate
Course content	Launching and recovery, boat handling, securing to a buoy, anchoring, leaving and coming alongside, man overboard
Ability after the course	Self-sufficient powerboater in the right conditions, aware of own limitations and those of their craft
